If you have ever attended an event that featured a speaker, you probably noticed that typically, there is an individual whose job is to introduce the speaker. The purpose of the introduction is to set the tone for what the speaker has to share. The audience wants to know why the speaker's presentation is relevant, the benefits, and what it will gain from the information. To sum it up, "What's in it for me?"

Good presenters do their research and learn as much as possible about the speaker. They familiarize themselves with the speaker's credibility, passion, knowledge, and accomplishments. They know the introduction should not be long and drawn out, but straight to the point covering the main focus.

One of the most prominent presenters of all time was John the Baptist. Even before he was born, God designated John the Baptist to announce the coming of the supreme orator of all time, Jesus Christ. I guess you could say that John was born to be a presenter.

John's introduction was short and simple yet powerful. John did not deliver his presentation in an auditorium, convention hall, or a church sanctuary. Instead, it was in the wilderness where John introduced the coming of Jesus. Pointing others to Jesus was John's main focus as he expressed to them their need for a Savior, Jesus Christ.

He is a voice shouting in the wilderness, Prepare the way for the Lord's coming! Clear the road for him! **Mark 1:3 (NLT)**

As we look throughout the Bible, we see other individuals who introduced Jesus to people they knew and strangers. For instance, there was the woman at the well who announced, "Come, see a Man who told me all things that I ever did. Could this be the Christ?" **John 4:29**. As a result, many sought and heard Jesus for themselves becoming believers in Christ (**John 4:42**). Then, there was Andrew who introduced his brother Simon Peter to Jesus proclaiming, "We have found the Messiah" **John 1:41-42**. Both Andrew and Peter became Jesus' disciples (**Matthew 10:2**).

Like John the Baptist and those in the Bible, we, too, are to become presenters of Christ. Our venue is wherever we have an opportunity. When we accepted Jesus into our lives, God designated us to become announcers of Christ. So, let us present to others the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world.
